

Nameplate lost? How to identify a Reeves MotoDrive

Your customer has an old workhorse Reeves MotoDrive and needs parts. You know that you need the original ID number to insure that you get the correct parts. But the nameplate is gone! All is not lost. Every Reeves MotoDrive built since the 1950's has the original ID number duplicated on the beltcase. The number is steel stamped into the cast iron rim under the belt inspection cover on the side of the beltcase. Remove the inspection cover and look on the machined rim around the edge, near the center of the case on the motor side. Easy!
